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In the centre of Olden, turn off along the road towards Briksdal Glacier (Briksdalsbreen) and Briksdalsbre Fjellstove. These are located at the end of the road, 24km into the Oldedalen Valley, a lush, idyllic valley that is full of water, rivers, waterfalls and huge mountains. You will have a view southwards of the Melkevoll Glacier, an arm of the Jostedal Glacier, but the Briksdal Glacier itself is to the east and cannot be seen from the road until you are well into the Briksdal Valley. Turn left at Melkevoll Bretun and drive 500m further on. Buses and cars can park at Briksdalsbre Fjellstove, where there is a café and large souvenir shop. Briksdal Breføring, a company that arranges trips on the glacier, is located here and you can also book a ride on a horse and trap.

You can walk the last 3km from Briksdalsbre Fjellstove up to the Briksdal Glacier or you can hire a horse and trap
